Project Brief

Construction of an extension to an existing agricultural shed to provide a new larger area to house calf and sheep.

Project Summary

The agricultural project required precise coordination with two other live, separate projects. The existing location for the calf and sheep was programmed to be demolished to accommodate a new car park, as part of a separate scheme.

Aspect 4 worked closely with both Main Contractors to maximise the transition between individual programmes; whilst minimising disruption and keeping key stakeholders informed throughout the process.
